Kia ora, and welcome

It has been a high energy week this week according to our Luna Calendar. The students have been in good spirits and engaged. We have seen a lot of tuakana – teina this week especially during our Poroti Springs Investigation on Tuesday. The classes were both animated during our Room for Rhythm sessions today, with the senior class experimenting with their home-made Chuka Chuks (percussion balls.)

Each of the six groups was fully immersed in the tasks at hand: scooping up a net full of 'Invertebrate,' sorting and classifying them, and recording the number. The puna (spring) was crystal clear and thriving with Invertebrate. We hope to visit the puna once a term to record during the different seasons and compare the fresh water life from one season to another. Whaea Hoana is teaching us the names and information about the Invertebrate through waiata that she has written for us. It will become a Poi waiata for our performance.

The Junior students wrote to me asking to have swings put up at the school. We have investigated this together with some of the Senior students. As part of the Inquiry we have looked at a location for the swings, what is already here at school, safety issues, what type of swing we could have i.e. individual, groups, natural, man-made or bought. We have started to make models of our favourite type of swing. Once all the information is put together we will take it to the next level, asking students and families what they think, or maybe a grant application or making our own.



Thank you everyone for your *amazing* support of our EASTER RAFFLE. We have raised a great amount of money which will go towards the students new swing. With so many tickets sold (over 500!!) we have decided to give a prize not just to the top raffle ticket seller but also to the "Super Sellers" selling so many sheets of tickets. There have also been a large array of chocolate and Easter treats making lots of prizes to send home to the lucky winners. Such a great effort.
