ASB First Aid presentation and workshops with Jo King. It was good to get an update on first aid processes. Do you know what RICED, FAST, OR DRSABS mean? Ask your children about 'dab- dab-far away mountain,' or 'dab-dab- ice cream scoop!'

Some interesting facts: Hospitalised = one night or more spent in hospital as a result of injury.

- 1 quad bike child every 2 weeks is hospitalised
- 4 burns every week hospitalised
- 5 kids poisoned hospitalised
- 7 cuts from sharp objects hospitalised
- 12 non-traffic transport e.g. bike, scooter hospitalised
- 70 falling hospitalised

This means 90 children per week are being hospitalised in New Zealand from things that could be prevented, so it is important to keep our kids up to date with what to do.

Attendance: This has reached a level of real concern not just in our school, but nationally. Every meeting I have attended as the Principal this topic has been top of the Agenda. Regular attendance at school ensures learning and a direction for our children's futures. It is linked very strongly to your child's wellbeing, as well as academic achievement. We need the support from home in this matter, so that we can do our best for your children. If they are not here, they miss out on their learning, and that affects their well-being, and it means catching up on what they have missed. We do understand there is sickness, and family matters that lead to absence. On a POSITIVE note **CONGRATULATIONS** to our students who attend on a very regular basis.
