Kia ora, and welcome

Thank you to those parents who attended our Parent 'Life in a Poroti School Classroom' meetings. It was lovely to meet with you, and be able to introduce some of our new parents to other parents as well. We hope you all learned something new. We as staff enjoy being able to share our programmes with you, and welcome any feedback or ideas. The message is please come and see us, or let us know before something small becomes a bigger issue.

Week 3 is coming to an end, and our students are well into their learning. Both classrooms are buzzing and coming to terms with the reality of being in the school routine, and adhering to our school values with their behaviour both inside and outside the classrooms. Just a few reminders given!

HOME LEARNING: The learning that comes home from our classes is to consolidate what is being done in class. Our assessments show that those who do their home learning regularly certainly show improvements in the class learning. Try to keep reading a relaxing time, support your child's mistakes, read some of the story yourself to them. Praise when they get things right. Make it fun to learn spelling, basic facts, and get involved yourself. We don't want home learning to be a conflict between you and your children. Pause. Breathe. Smile.

With the changing weather and then moving into winter, we need to be vigilant with our health and that of our students. *Please watch for symptoms of COVID-19. If any of the following symptoms develop, ring Healthline on 0800 358 5453 or your doctor. Common symptoms of COVID -19 are like those found in illnesses such as a cold or the influenza. You may have one or more of the following:*

- New or worsening cough
- Sneezing and runny nose fever
- Temporary loss of smell or altered sense of taste
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath.

While "Improving Attendance' is a school-wide target for 2022, we also want to ensure that we keep our community as safe as we can. If you are unsure ring Healthline or your doctor for advice.
