They will be placed on the four State Highway entrances to the village so the hunt is on for four designs. Winning designers will receive \$300 and see their design welcoming people to Maungatapere. Four chances of winning, enter as many times as you like. Designs need to be rectangular with landscape orientation. Designs should include the word 'Maungatapere' and any other words you like with a maximum of 6 words. Your design may be a mountain backdrop, a historical scene or something depicting our vibrant farming community or something else. It can be a (high-resolution) photo, original artwork or something else. Entries close 5pm 15th October with designs assessed first by the Maungatapere Village Inc committee for practicality then the community will decide the winners. Voting will then close 11th November and winners will be notified by mail. Winning designs may be modified to align with the other signs.
