Kia ora and welcome to Poroti School

Welcome back to Roitana and his whānau. Roitana has joined the Senior class bringing our school roll to 45. We have had some 4-year olds having their school visits which is exciting as we get closer to that magic roll number of 51 and open a third classroom.

Think and Be Me ... Cat and Willi came to school today with their messages around emotions using 'Worry Watchdog,' 'Angry Dragon' and 'Cool Cat.' These characters play a role in our thoughts and feelings. This was an introduction to our students and staff, followed by a staff meeting with the theory behind the programme.

Today we learnt how to **Notice it, Name it** – i.e. Worried. Am I scared, nervous, stressed, guilt or judged. One feeling can represent many things.

Calm your body. Calm your brain. - Take time to notice, talk about it, breathe, take a break

Catch it – the 'stinking thinking' i.e. you are dumb! **Check it –** Is that thought true, kind or helpful? **Change it** i.e. I am kind, I am fun, I am awesome.

As we work through this with the children we will send resources and links home for whānau to use with their tamariki and mokopuna.

MANGAKAHIA SUMMER FESTIVAL: Thank you to those who have already donated and offered to help on the day. This is a great day to promote our school in the community and make some money for camps.
