Kia ora and welcome to Poroti School

A warm welcome to Xandr and his whānau. Xandr has joined Te Weu (our Junior room). We are very happy to have you here and we hope you enjoy your time with us at Poroti School.

I hope the deluge of rain has not affected you too much? It did not dampen the ability to get out in the garden during Garden to Table – although we were not prepared for that much rain, but . . . our store of dry, warm clothes came in handy afterwards. We had Lucretia (an Environmental Educator) with us sorting out the compost bins that our Boys' Club made many years ago, so we thought it was time to resurrect them and use them again. Always pack a jacket and boots or shoes on a Tuesday rain or shine we are out there!

ATTENDANCE: As part of the government's target of getting 80% of students attending school regularly that is 90% of the time we will be monitoring our student's attendance and communicating with you should we have concerns. **Last term our regular attendance for Poroti School was 67%.** This is 13% below the 80% target. LET'S HIT THAT TARGET IN TERM 2! 80% attending for 90% of the term. (It's only 9 weeks this term)



Regular attendance at school is important to your child's success and there is a clear connection between going to school regularly and doing well in class. Making sure students attend and engage in learning is a shared responsibility. As a parent, you are responsible for making sure your child attends school every day. If your child is absent or is going to be absent it is essential that you let us know please. We acknowledge that there are genuine reasons students may be absent, however, without regular attendance your child will struggle to make progress. We are committed to supporting your child to attend school. If you are having difficulty getting your child to school, you can ask for our support. We can work with you to develop a support plan that addresses any barriers to regular attendance.
