### **The B.F.G.**

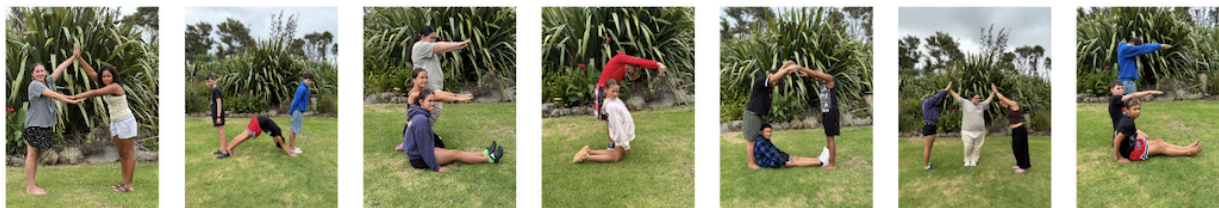
