There are also plenty of exciting changes happening out behind the school, including work on our new track. While progress is coming along wonderfully, **the track is not yet open to students or the public.**

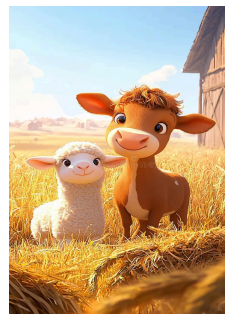
